

Ravensbridge Business Meeting

- Officer Reports : Seneschal and Herald have sent 4th Quarter reports. All other officers need to send Quarterly reports both to Malagentia and Seneschal (Kyppyn). Kyp is sending a sample report to Sigrid, Deputy A&S officer to aid in completing A&S Quarterly reports.
- Hugin and Munnin Event: Dave Poulin as Autocrat has secured Monmouth Fish and Game for our first event! Potential dates were discussed and May 16 selected to avoid conflict with other SCA events. Site fee is \$100 plus \$1 per person, which includes access to the building with full kitchen and grounds. Archery, Thrown Weapons and Heavy List will have plenty of room. Rapier will be included if a Marshall can be located and if there is enough interest.
 - o Member Entry Fee will be \$10 per person, \$5pp for Feast. Of the \$10pp, \$1 goes to site, \$1.50 for Dayboard budget, \$7.50pp to site fee \$100 any extra to Ravensbridge account.
 - o Amy McCollett will be in charge of Dayboard, which is included in entry fee.
 - o Feast Steward is Sabine de Rouen who will be rounding up volunteers for kitchen crew. Clean up crew will be separate group of volunteers. Feast Reservations made to Autocrat.
 - o All other set-up and take-down will be managed by each group leader.
 - o Heavy List Marshall Kyppyn proposes: Silver Hammer- a Hammer shaped arena; Tavern Brawl with kids invited to throw duct-tape made weapons/objects at fighters; Double Elimination Tourney
 - o A&S competition Norse vs. Knowne World; functional objects only, ie carved eating knife, blacksmith work for cooking, tools. No purely decorative items
 - o Prizes: donations needed!!
 - o Silent Auction: also donations needed! Dece will contact Malyssia Smith to ask her to run it.
 - o Children's Activities: We need someone to apply to be an SCA Youth Leader ASAP due to the time needed for the background check. Only SCA done background checks apply; teacher credentials, etc are not accepted. Ideas: Kids "scavenge" pieces of a message from "killed" tourney fighters, make duct-tape objects to throw at fighters in Tavern Brawl.
 - o Troll: Amy and Dece volunteered to help Exchequer and Chatelaine (Paul and Cece) run Gate. Kyp has all necessary forms and Dece will be attending a Troll training through EK University.
 - o Dece has volunteered to be Deputy Autocrat!
